- Typical Session Length - 1 Hour
- We offer a variety of frequency options, such as one-off or a series of workshops.
- We offer 2 types of delivery modes: In-person and Online.

Workshop Content

Workshops offered by Stemsphere Foundation have a variety of different structures. Below is an example of what a typical workshop would contain.

- A fun and engaging Hands-on Project that reflects the main topic discussed.
- Different variations of Group Activities that give students realistic examples of STEM and its connection to our everyday lives.
- A final Discussion and Reflection to restate our purpose and reflect on the topic.



Ideal Student Group

Our ideal group of students are in middle school, and no experience is needed for any of our provided workshops.

Our recommended group size is flexible, but we recommend around 5-30 students per group.
